- 2. Commit to all elements of the Challenge Checklist.
- 3. Commit to providing additional support to pupils not meeting the minimum expectations of progress as stated in the chosen SSP programme.
- 4. Share all requested documentation and data with the English Hub in line with the agreed action plan and know information may be shared between the Hub, the Department for Education and the English Hubs Council.
- Ensure that there is an identified and suitably experienced <u>KS1 reading / Phonics leader</u> in school with <u>appropriate time</u> to support the implementation of the changes identified and agreed.
- 6. Ensure the reading leader sets up and runs <u>regular practice</u> and coaching sessions for the reading team.
- 7. Ensure that the Headteacher and all teachers and support staff in Reception, Year 1 and year 2 (as a minimum) attend the funded SSP training. (If not already done)
- 8. Ensure that all Reception and Year 1 and 2 teachers follow your chosen phonics programme **(SSP name)** with fidelity throughout the intensive support period.
- 9. Commit to using only **SSP** *Resources* for the duration of their membership as a partner school of the English Hubs programme, consulting with the English Hub if they feel they need to change their SSP programme for any reason.
- 10. Agree to, and cooperate within a reasonable timeframe, any quality assurance activities, including visits by representatives of the English Hubs Programme
